- ___ 5. The “*Apocrypha*” refers to books that are not part of the Bible, but historically interesting.
- ___ 6. Because poetry is about feelings and creativity, God did not inspire any Biblical books which include poetry.

- ___ 8. The word “Epistle” is simply a Greek word for “letter.”
