Luther's *Small Catechism*

“True” (“T”) or “False” (“F”)

- ___ 1. That God gets “jealous” over us shows how much He loves us.
- ___ 2. The only time God gave the Ten Commandments was on Mt. Sinai.
- ___ 3. Even if God didn’t give us the Ten Commandments on Mt. Sinai we could pretty much know what God wanted from us.
- ___ 4. When we consider Jesus’ summary of the Ten Commandments in Matthew 22:37-39, the best summary of the Ten Commandments is “Law.”
- ___ 5. Martin Luther taught that since there are TEN Commandments, that there are also TEN uses of the Law. Each use applies to each commandment.
- ___ 6. The Third Use of the Law, that of “Guide,” applies *only* to Christians.
- ___ 7. The purpose of the “curb” use of the Law is to prevent us from sinning.
- ___ 8. Since there are no “command” words in the Ten Commandments, the translations “Thou shalt/shalt not” or “You shall/shall not” are really incorrect.
